1. Tee boxes : (flat, manicured, multiple options)

4. Rough: (Consistent, playable, not too penal)
5. Bunkers: (maintained, enough rakes, playable)
6. Hazards: (strategic, pertinent and balanced in number)
7. Greens, Maintenance: (no pitch marks, disease, etc.)
8. Greens, Playability: (hold shots, true roll, consistent speed, fair)
9. Greens, Variety: (pin placement options, fair undulations, well protected)
