IN coming years golfers will be greeted by consistent improvements to the course layout as Noosa Golf Club works through an extensive Master Plan program to renovate each of its 18 holes, five of which have been successfully completed to rave reviews.

The club, ideally located on the Cooroy Noosa Road, on the edge of the Tewantin National Park in an idyllic natural tropical parkland setting, is undertaking the ambitious renovation while continuing to provide golfers with an outstanding championship course because it is, in

All greens will be converted to Tiff Eagle grass, while tees will be Zoysa grass. Vice-president John Purdue ensured that during the various course projects golfers would at all times be playing an outstanding 18-hole course, with no temporary tees or greens in play.

The \$4.5 million project which is being overseen by Atlas Golf - includes the re-design of every hole, including the enlargement of greens, re-construction and design of all bunkers using the

incredible Dura-Crumb technique, turf replacement and hole routing. Whilst the existing holes already feature excellent topography and playability, the new designs will undoubtedly take the club to the next level in terms of its overall ranking and popularity in the golf community.

The progressive nature of the club, and the ambitious plans are set to see the Noosa GC grow its already popular reputation.

The club is also famous for being genuinely welcoming to all visitors, whether they be golfers or not. The clubhouse is a popular community

meeting place and preferred venue for a chilled evening out. The Bistro offers lunch specials every weekday, dinner from Wednesday to Friday, and its trivia nights - on the first Wednesday of each month - are almost always booked out. 

MOUNT COOLUM GOLF CLUB

JUST 10 minutes drive from the Sunshine Coast (Maroochydore) Airport, the picturesque Mount Coolum Golf Club offers a challenging and interesting layout that is home to two mobs of kangaroos, a resident goanna on the 11th hole, and an abundance of other wildlife that golfers of all standards can enjoy.

The reputation of the golf course is growing rapidly as the condition and presentation continues to improve thanks to a small but skilled and dedicated team of course staff.

Measuring 5901m from the black tees, and 5149m from the reds, the unusual composition of six par-3 holes, six par-4 holes, and six par-5s offers some relief for inexperienced golfers on the short holes, whilst requiring some accurate tee shots from big-hitters on the longer holes.

Social golfers can get on the course most days with Mondays, Fridays and

Sundays having the most availability. Full membership is available, as are lower-cost entry-level categories such as the social golfer membership, and the pay-as-you-play membership.

Mount Coolum has a reputation of being a friendly club with welcoming staff and an active and engaged membership.

The clubhouse offers sweeping views of Mount Coolum from the decks, and has a wide range of beers on tap – including popular local craft brews. Benny's Bistro is open for lunch from Wednesday to Sunday, and for evening meals on Friday night.

Mount Coolum also accepts group bookings and is popular with social golf clubs and, with most competitions being open, including Saturdays, it also a great option for a weekend away or golf holiday.

CALOUNDRA GOLF CLUB

NOT far from famed Kings Beach at Caloundra is the equally impressive Caloundra Golf Club.

The charming parkland golf course is set in a tranquil and peaceful environment and offers a pleasant combination of ponds and well-established trees and interesting strategy decisions off the tees.

Of course, the challenge of the traditional Australian bushland course is another reason why the club is popular with members and visitors alike. Off the championship tees, the golf course stretches to 5957 metres (5363m for women).

The delightful, picturesque course features a number of tight, tree-lined holes that make accuracy and the ability to shape the golf ball off the tee important. And that means the layout is a balance between risk and reward.

There are five par-3s and they are a real test with none measuring less than 145 metres. If that is not enough, there is water on five holes and bunkers protect most greens.

Caloundra golf course's final three holes are extremely demanding – just what you want from a championship layout.

If you require one birdie from the final three holes to win a title, you are going to have to work very hard indeed.

Caloundra GC, which can lay claim to producing former Open champion Ian Baker-Finch, has produced numerous state and national champions. Visitors are always welcome at Caloundra and social times are available most days.

Motorised carts and golf equipment are available for hire.

The clubhouse, which overlooks the 18th green and fairway, incorporates a fully equipped bar and dining room and also specialises in engagements, birthdays or any other celebration while the pro shop has an excellent range of clubs and accessories.

MAROOCHY RIVER GOLF CLUB

THE first thing you notice about Maroochy River Golf Club (MRGC) is the spectacular view to Mount Coolum. Undulating fairways and breathtaking water features sit proudly below one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the Sunshine Coast.

Since opening in June 2015, Maroochy River GC has blossomed into a world class destination, with an impressive average of over 80,000 rounds per year.

When Graham Marsh designed and built Maroochy River, he promised a gutsy (risk-and-reward) course, and he certainly delivered, with the layout presenting a challenge to level of players.

Rated #42 in Australia's Top 100 Public Access Courses and is #71 in Australia's Top 100 Golf Courses for 2024, Maroochy River features one superb hole after another, tee shots and greens are protected by bunkers, plenty of water and a family of black swans for those lucky enough to see them.

Profoundly different to any other course in Queensland, the links-style layout winds its way through strategic waterways and wetlands and is described by members and visitors alike as an "awesome experience".

The course has held 11 State titles and two National titles including the 2019 Australian Men's Senior Amateur Championships. The Schweppes PGA Legends Pro-Am (Qld Senior PGA Championship) will be a featured two-day event on the calendar once again in December 2025.

Prices for visitor green fees are \$110.00 for 18 Holes or \$60.00 for 9 Holes. Right now, MRGC are offering a Mates Rates special for four golfers which includes two carts for only \$440.00.

For those golfers who enjoy warming up before a round, Maroochy River has warm up at the nets or on the full-length, state-of-the-art driving range, excellent practice facilities which are open every day and some evenings.

After golf, head to the Cane Cutters Bar & Bistro, which also has a gaming lounge with new machines. The modern clubhouse, with a huge deck overlooking the 18th green and magnificent views north to Mt Coolum, will delight any visitor especially at sunset.

The bar has 17 taps of different beers, including a few local craft beer favourites. Families and friends love coming out in the fresh air, having some drinks and staying for a pizza or snack. It's a terrific family friendly atmosphere.

The very popular Mini Golf Course is open seven-days from 9am until late. Described as one of the best in Australia and there are online gift vouchers available, this is a great way to let the family have some fun too. The kids will love it. The facility is fully licenced and floodlit for all day play.
