SANDS TORQUAY GOLF CLUB

THE Stuart Appleby-designed Sands Torquay golf course is an 18-hole links-style layout that intriguingly winds through the land behind the sand dunes of Zeally Bay on the Bellarine Peninsula.

PORT FAIRY GOLF CLUB

WINDING its way through natural sand dunes, with spectacular views of the Southern Ocean to the south, Port Fairy Golf Club is a classic links-style course that is reminiscent of the great layouts found in Great Britain and Ireland.

So, if you've ever wanted to play a real traditional links course, but don't fancy flying to the other side of the world to do so, Port Fairy GC is the perfect alternative.

Located five kilometres east of the historic township of Port Fairy, the course currently holds a ranking of the 27th in Golf Australia Magazine's recent top 100. Former European touring professional and golf course architect Mike Clayton once rated it as "the best value golf in Australia".

There are numerous highlights on this outstanding course. The fifth hole, a 448m par-5, is one of the most beautiful holes on the course with a lovely wide and undulating fairway that sweeps uphill and curves from left to right. Strategically placed bunkers demand

accuracy on the second shot before the approach to a fast back-to-front sloping green.

The eighth is a stunning 122m downhill par-3 to a large rolling green that requires anything from a wedge to a 3-iron depending on the wind and skill of the golfer.

Holes 12 to 16 are agreed by many to be among the best stretch of golf holes in the country, with spectacular ocean views (providing frequent sightings of southern right whales during the winter and early spring) and some very challenging hole designs.

The 12th is a 470m par-5 along the ocean with fabulous views. The right-hand side is all OOB, and treacherous swathes of marram grass await the wayward shot to the left.

The 409m 14th, which was named by Inside Golf readers as the best 14th hole in Australia, plays straight at the ocean and is nearly impossible to reach in two into the wind ... and extremely difficult to hold when played downwind.



At 5887 metres, the course is not long compared to some of the more modern designs but it is more than enough if the wind is blowing, which is often. It's a fantastic traditional links course that will test all players who make the journey out to Port Fairy.

13TH BEACH GOLF LINKS

THE Bellarine Peninsula is fast becoming one of the key locations for avid golfers around the country. 13th Beach Golf Links perpetuates this with a focus on continuous improvement whilst retaining the long-standing history that the Club has established after 20 years of existence.

The foundation of the courses, designed by Tony Cashmore and Sir Nick Faldo, combined with the fresh ideas and experience of course design consultant, Darius Oliver, sets the club up for the future.

A detailed course Improvement program by Darius Oliver is well underway, and we are excited to see the opportunities and enjoyment for all levels of golfers. The Thirteenth Beach Short Course has further enhanced the value offer for members and guests with 45 holes now available for play.

The Beach Course, much of which winds through spectacular foreshore sand dunes adjacent to the famous Thirteenth surf beach, is widely acclaimed as one of Australia's best courses.

In 2022, it was ranked No. 8 of Public Access Courses in Australia and No. 4 on the mainland. The key feature of the Beach Course is its wonderful set of par3s.

There's the challenging 180m third hole, the dainty yet sinister 113m 16th, while the seventh and 12th use nature at its best, nestled in natural sand dunes with challenging greens and deep bunkers.

The Creek Course, designed by Cashmore in conjunction with Sir Nick Faldo, is a wonderful contrast to the Beach Course.

The Creek Course, ranked No. 23 of Public Access Courses in Australia, No. 19 on the mainland, is regularly compared to some of Melbourne's best sandbelt courses.

The Short Course, also designed by Tony Cashmore, was opened on March 8, 2021. Comprising nine holes with multiple tees ranging from 105 metres to 188 metres and a gentle walk, it is suitable for all levels of golfers.

Each hole presents a unique challenge with undulating greens and surrounds with run-offs and swales to challenge approach shots and all aspects of the short game.

It is accessible for all levels of player – from beginner to experienced golfer alike – and takes only an hour to play.

13th Beach Golf Lodges complement this premier destination perfectly with 16 beautifully appointed studio rooms and 4x2 bedroom suites, catering up to a total of 48 quests.

Stay-and-play packages are specially designed to cater for individual groups.

Other facilities include a first-class driving range, dedicated chipping green, two practice putting greens, practice nets and a modern clubhouse.

ANGLESEA GOLF CLUB

ANGLESEA Golf Club was first established in 1950 and its history tells of land purchases, acquisitions and refurbishment over the years

In the 1990s, the fairways were transformed and in 2000 recycled water was connected.

There are many features that make a visit to Anglesea Golf Course a unique experience and must-do when travelling the Great Ocean Road.

The course is an undulating 6074m par-73 layout set in natural bushland. A feature of the course is the number of elevated greens that require plenty of thought when selecting your club.

Golf Links

Added to the mix are 42 "sandbelt-style" bunkers sprinkled throughout the course, eucalypt tree-lined fairways and the everpresent resident population of around 300 Eastern Grey kangaroos. These features all combine to produce a stimulating round of

The club has a dedicated 250-metre driving range with six individual bays, allowing ample flexibility and accessibility for everyone who wants to practice. The 70 metre wide range allows plenty of space for everyone from beginners to the seasoned veteran. A bucket of balls costs just \$12 to hire. There are also three chipping greens to help you develop your approach shots and short game tactics.

The club operates nature-based kangaroo tours run by volunteer members which are

popular amongst non-golfing tourists. Tour operating dates and times will be released soon - keep an eye on our Facebook page and website for details.

While at the club, guests can also enjoy a game of mini-golf on the 18-hole rolling fairways course in a bush setting.

Golf memberships are available for sevenday, junior and the 18-39-year-old categories. Social golfers/green fee players are welcome every day.

Green fees range from \$40 (nine holes) to \$65 (18 holes). Junior rates are \$25/\$35. Club, pull buggy and motorised cart hire is available.

The clubhouse bar and bistro are open for lunch and dinner seven days a week. The fine dining restaurant sits comfortably between traditional pub food and a five-star fine dining experience by providing a little of both in a menu that is as varied as the tastes of its

There's also a magnificent deck that overlooks the 18th fairway and accommodates up to 180 patrons - perfect for a drink or two and an opportunity to revel in the sunshine or the evening breeze.
