### PELICAN WATERS GOLF CLUB

If there's one holiday location in our country that simply exudes "Great Aussie Golf Getaway", especially as we head into winter, it is the Sunshine Coast. And there are two obvious (and literal) reasons for that: The "sunshine" and the exquisite "coast".

Pelican Waters Golf Club is situated at the southern end of the Sunshine Coast just minutes from the warm sand and revitalising surf. Just north of Pelican Waters is Golden Beach and just a little bit further along are the renowned beaches of Caloundra. Think Golden Beach, Kings Beach and Dicky Beach, for starters. Designed by Greg Norman, this course is currently in pristine condition given it hosted the 2021 Isuzu Queensland Open in recent months. Beside getting the course itself to a stellar condition, a mammoth effort went into building new golf cart paths and upgrading facilities in the lead-up to the Open. All these enhancements are now for the members and general public to continue to enjoy.

Pelican Waters Golf Course has been ranked Number 1 public access golf course on the Sunshine Coast and also Number 25 of the top 100 public access courses in Australia. The currently 6289m, Par 72 course was designed into the existing natural landscape to deliver a challenging golfing terrain. With its enviable backdrop of the majestic Glasshouse Mountains, the course has been described one of the most unique and rewarding on the Sunshine Coast.

What is most exciting about this course, however, is its future. Owned and operated by the Palm Lake Group, Pelican Waters Golf

Club is undergoing a massive renovation and extension right now. The clubhouse precinct will soon be home to a high-tech golf training academy, driving range, a lakeside glass wedding chapel and an Australian-first, Greg Norman-designed mini golf course. The clubhouse itself will be completely transformed and extended to bring more of the golfing ambience direct to patrons, with huge viewing decks looking out across the course and celebrating the 18th hole.

As part of this planned development, a luxury over-50s community lifestyle resort will be constructed right alongside the course. Palm Lake Resort Pelican Waters will, undoubtedly, be the most opulent community within the Palm Lake Group portfolio which currently features 28 communities across three states of Australia. More than 11,000 people call a Palm Lake Group address home.

If the thought of living in a secure, luxury, over-50s golfing community on the stunning Sunshine Coast excites you, maybe you should find time to stop by the Palm Lake

### NOOSA SPRINGS GOLF & SPA RESORT

Of the 1500 or more public golf courses in Australia, Golf Course Guide rates Noosa Springs in the top 35. That should tell you something about the quality of this tropical gem situated just a few minutes' drive from iconic Noosa Heads on Queensland's Sunshine Coast.

But it's not just the magnificent course that visitors rave about when, eventually and usually reluctantly, they leave the clubhouse

after a memorable round of golf.

It's the charm and beauty of the surroundings, the warmth of the welcome and, most of all, the outstanding service provided by Noosa Springs' dedicated staff that remains in the memory.

Noosa Springs is a bit of everything.

It's a resort, offering luxury accommodation, a world-class spa, tennis, a fitness centre and a restaurant that serves its own unique brand of quality cuisine.

It's also a members' club, with a cohort of

enthusiastic golfers regularly competing against each other for prizes and bragging rights.

But it's also a golf facility where visitors are encouraged and always made welcome, irrespective of their ability on the fairways.

Designed by golf architect Graham Papworth, the par-72 6180m layout is set amidst tropical bushland, making for an enjoyable, yet challenging, round of golf.

Water comes into play on 12 of the holes and the fairways are framed by stands of tropical

rainforest. But it's the beauty of the place, the care with which the course is maintained and the quiet peace of the natural surroundings that linger in the memory.

Visiting golfers have seven-days-a-week access to the course, and the opportunity to play in competitions such as the weekly Sunday Series, the annual Queensland A, B & C Championships and the quarterly Noosa Springs Skins and Ladies Series, which attract players from near and far.

Casual green fees (for 18 holes) are \$125, but that includes the cost of an electric cart, and frequent special offers allow golfers the opportunity of playing this wonderful course at very reasonable rates. You can also save by booking online.

There are special rates for groups of 12 or more, while locals – those who live on the Sunshine Coast or Gympie – can play on Tuesdays and Sundays for \$79 (with a cart). Kids play free every day after 3pm with a paying adult.

## MOUNT COOLUM TEAM CLASSIC – 6-8 JUNE

The Mount Coolum 3-Day Team Classic is back!

Like many events in 2020, this great event was not conducted last year due to the restrictions imposed associated with the Covid-19 pandemic.

First played in 2016, this event has become a fixture on the calendar for many golfers - both local to the area and visitors from afar.

The Team Classic can be contested by any combination of male and female golfers with GA handicaps.

The format of the event sees the teams contest a 4BBB Stableford on Sunday 6th June before a welcome Cocktail Party, then a 2-Ball Ambrose the following morning with the Classic Dinner that evening. A seeded draw is done for the final round - a 4-Ball Aggregate Stableford on the morning of Tuesday 8th June, before a light lunch and presentation wraps up the event by mid-afternoon.

The Mount Coolum course is situated between the iconic Mount Coolum and the Sunshine Coast Airport. The course itself measures 5698m from the Blue Tees (which will be used for this event) for the

men, and 5149m from the Red Tees for the women. Although the course is not long, it is regarded as a tight driving course which can challenge golfers of all standards, but still reward good play. The course has a rather unusual configuration, in that it features six par-3 holes, six par-4s, and six par-5s.

For visitors interested in playing in the event, there are dozens of accommodation options within 10mins drive of the course, from Coolum Beach to the north through Marcoola and Mudjimba.

The Nomination Fee - which includes catering (but not drinks!) at 3 functions, is \$195 / player for visitors, and \$135 for members of the host club.

Many a ball has gone swimming.

The greens are slippery, so trying to stop your ball is a challenge, especially holes 9 and 18. But do not be put off by the challenges of this lovely country course. The staff and members are friendly and quick with a G'day and a well-deserved cold beer. Sit out the back in the beer garden and watch the native flora and fauna whilst sipping on a cold one. Midweek and weekend competitions available. Or try their Friday Fun: afternoon golf with no need of a handicap. Anyone can play, leading into Friday night BBQ and raffles with fun to be had by everyone.

Jump on the boat to Keppel Island once the golf is finished and explore the beautiful beaches on offer whilst perhaps spotting a whale or two. With more sunshine than any other Australian capital and breathtaking landscapes to match, Yeppoon is an enjoyable stop for golfers and non-golfers alike.

With the perfect tranquil backdrop for your special occasion, Yeppoon Golf Club makes for a picturesque wedding venue. Their facilities are available for all functions. The fully trained staff will ensure you and your guests will be treated attentively and professionally on your special day.

So one must consider playing this as a par-4 rather than a par-3, but then again, you decide!

## MAROOCHE RIVER GOLF CLUB

The first thing you notice about Maroochy River Golf Club is the spectacular view to Mount Coolum. Undulating fairways and breathtaking water features sit proudly below one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the Sunshine Coast.

Since opening in June 2015, Maroochy River Golf Club has really blossomed into a world-class destination, with an impressive average of 75,000 rounds per year.

The Graham Marsh-designed layout will challenge all level of players and leave you wanting to come back for more. When Marsh designed and built Maroochy River he promised a gutsy (risk-and-reward) course, and he certainly delivered.

The course is rated #54 in Australia's Top 100 Public Access Courses, and is named in Australia's Top 100 Golf Courses debuting at #76.

At Maroochy River there is one superb hole after another, featuring stunning drives and greens protected by bunkers, plenty of water and a family of black swans if you are lucky enough to see them.

Profoundly different to any other course in Queensland, the links-style layout winds its way through strategic waterways and wetlands. It has matured beautifully and is described by members and visitors alike as an "awesome experience".

"We have many repeat visitors who just love the place," said general manager Charlie McGill.

The course has held eight State titles and two National titles including the 2019 Australian Men's Senior Amateur Championships. The Schweppes PGA Legends Pro-Am will be a featured 2-day event on the calendar for 2021.

# SCONE GOLF COURSE

The new, improved Scone Golf Course is open to the public.

The 9 hole (18 tees) 6,044 metre par 72 layout is situated in the picturesque Upper Hunter region of New South Wales, just 2 hours from Newcastle and a comfortable 3+ hour drive from Sydney.

The new course includes manicured kikuyu fairways and USGA specified tees and bent grass greens. A fully automated irrigation system, on site bore and two enlarged ponds storing treated water.

It has natural features like gullies and mature Red River Gums, as well as the thousands of plants that have been put in, which has improved the diversity and ecology of the site.

The new course is open to the public everyday (except block times for Member competitions on Saturdays (social play after 3pm) and Ladies 9 hole on Thursday mornings).

**MALENY GOLF CLUB**

The scenic Sunshine Coast Hinterland and Maleny's award-winning links-style course combine perfectly to create an attractive golfing getaway for those seeking a unique golfing encounter and lashings of good old-fashioned country hospitality.

Nestled within the lush green hinterland, the club's quality, 18-hole public course provides golfers with a picturesque, Scottish-inspired "golf-as-it-began" playing experience and an extraordinary array of accommodation options nearby.

Home to former international touring professional Wayne Perske, the golf club is just minutes from the township of Maleny and has clubs, pull buggies and a fleet of 25 motorised carts for hire.

The club is offering a special Stay and Play package until the end of August comprising cart hire and 18 holes for two players for \$79 on presentation of a valid receipt for hinterland accommodation and the accompanying advertisement in Inside Golf.

Located high in the hills to the west of Caloundra and less than 90 minutes' drive north of Brisbane, an excursion to Maleny guarantees an enjoyable golfing getaway.

From the elevated Par-3 first tee, players are presented with a panoramic view of the course and an ideal vantage point from which to assess the golfing challenge ahead.

Players will encounter some stern tests of golf along the way, including deep revetted bunkers defending the greens, swirling winds and a penal kikuyu long rough for those who stray too far from the well-defined fairways.

The cool hinterland breezes will provide golfers some welcome relief during Queensland's long, hot summer, although they can complicate club choice at times too.

The Graham Papworth-designed Par 69 course is comprised of three par-5s, 9 par-4s and six par-3s. Masters Champion and former World Number One Adam Scott streamed 9 holes with Perske on Instagram in May last year after earlier shooting a course record 62.

Maleny's innovative design takes full advantage of some excellent natural assets –

gentle rolling hills, well-drained volcanic soil, existing pastures, surrounding rainforest and some wetland.

The course has been built to a high standard under the direction of course superintendent Mick McCombe using the latest agronomic technology and knowhow to construct the Tiff Dwarf greens.

Supported by a band of dedicated volunteers, McCombe has transformed what was once a weed-ridden old dairy farm into a quality golf course praised by all who play it.

The club, which opened in 2015, has cleverly combined two shipping containers to establish a rustic HQ incorporating a deck and marquee where players can enjoy a post round beverage or two.

The club operates under a Covid-Safe compliance plan for the protection of staff, members and guests.

## THE KOORALBYN VALLEY

Escape the city to enjoy nature at its best in the heart of the beautiful Scenic Rim.

The Kooralbyn Valley is an iconic, integrated golf resort located in the beautiful Scenic Rim region of Queensland, a region fast becoming known as a booming tourism area due to its world-class scenery, charming country towns and an array of regional produce. On the doorstep of the Gold Coast and Brisbane, it's an easy 90-minute drive through thoroughbred horse and cattle country, or if you prefer you can take a plane and land on the local airstrip (just watch out for the kangaroos and the locals walking their dogs!). If you are after a complete break from the city while still being able to enjoy the challenge of a world-class golf course, this is the place for you.

The 18-hole championship golf course opened for play in October 1979, with the legendary Greg Norman as its tour professional. Within two years it was chosen to host the 1981 Queensland Open, a fitting

tribute to its superb design. The Kooralbyn Valley is Australia's first integrated golf resort and is the go-to golfing holiday destination for thousands of keen golfers from Australia and overseas. The resort flourished during the boom period of the eighties and nineties and was a millionaire's playground, with Kerry Packer being a regular guest.

Renowned Scottish designer, Desmond Muirhead, said that the landsite was one of the best he has worked with in all of the 80 courses he has designed around the world. Kooralbyn is Muirhead at his best, a master of design which has no conflict with nature. Muirhead's design of the 220-metre par-3 fifth, that drops some 100 feet, featured in Robert Muir Graves and Geoffrey S. Cornish's book, "Classic Golf Hole Design" and was one of a handful of showstoppers during a round.

In 2008, the resort went into receivership as a result of the global financial crisis, although the golf course was kept in use by keen locals. In 2016, the resort was bought by Peter Huang of Yong Real Estate Group and after extensive

refurbishments, was once again open to the public. Since that time, it has gone ahead in leaps and bounds and has regained its position as one of the top golf courses in the country.

Situated on 800 acres, the resort is the largest accommodation provider in the Scenic Rim, offering unique dining experiences in the upmarket Lilies Restaurant and the pub-style Pavilion Tavern. It is home to a large population of Eastern Grey kangaroos, Pretty Face wallabies and Redneck wallabies, as well as an abundance of native birdlife inhabiting the wetlands. 

The first four holes on 1-9 take you away from the clubhouse and head in the direction of Ferny Grove. Any player who is struggling with losing the ball to the left may want to stock up on balls from the golf shop, as out of bounds is well and truly in play with the railway line lurking just beyond the boundary fence. In saying this, reasonably generous fairways and large putting surfaces provide the player the opportunity to get their round off to a good start. This nine can however lull you into a false sense of security.

Holes 10-18 require length and accuracy, with correct shot selection and execution necessary in order to play this nine successfully. The final four holes of this nine will either make or break your round, with water a prominent feature as you come down the stretch. Hole 15 will see you face a tricky tee shot down the hill. Go too far, however, and a watery grave awaits. The 16th will also test your nerve off the tee with a newly introduced dam ready to capture any ball that strays left of the fairway. Hole 17 is

a demanding 190m par-3 across water with bunkers on either side ready to receive tee shots too much to the left or right. Finally we come to the 18th, a tee shot where you want to be as far down the fairway as you can in order to make your 2nd shot as short as possible to a well bunkered, two tiered elevated green that will test all your skill with the putter.

Holes 19-27 place a premium on accuracy and with the Kedron Brook winding its way throughout this nine, any wayward shots are more likely to find a hazard than not. The combinations of these three very different nines will be sure to test all facets of any golfer's game and a good score will certainly be well earned.

Keperra Country Golf Club is open to the social player 7 days a week. The club has a well-stocked Golf Shop with an extensive range of clothing and equipment. The opportunity to unwind after the round can be found by making your way upstairs to the fully licensed bar and bistro for a refreshing drink and bite to eat.






Thai, which offers authentic Thai cuisine.



The course has natural features like gullies and mature Red River Gums, as well as the thousands of plants that have been put in, which has improved the diversity and ecology of the site.

Play is open to the general public every day with the exception of member competition block times on Saturdays from 7:30am to 9:00am and 11:00am to 1:00pm. Thursday mornings - Ladies 9 hole competition.

Scone Golf Course has already played host to a Hunter River District Golf Association 36-hole event. More recently, the HRDGA Ladies Golf Playoff Day was held and was a resounding success with a number of visitors vowing to return.
