

PAMBULA MERIMBULA GOLF CLUB

NATURAL beauty abounds with bushland, wildlife and views over Merimbula Lake which are simply dazzling.

Situated between two of the Sapphire Coast's hugely popular tourist towns, Pambula Merimbula Golf Club is a high standard, 27-hole championship course.

As each nine has its individual character, you can play a variety of courses and conditions, lengths and challenges – all at the one location. It's a relatively easy walk which can be enjoyed by golfers of all levels.

The first nine is shorter than 10-18 and 19-27 but includes some terrific holes, while 19-27 is the longest and probably the most difficult nine holes. For instance, check out the 182-metre 27th, uphill and over water.

Depending on which combination is played, the course varies from 5780 metres (par 71) to 6214 metres (par 73).

The greens are large and subtle, presenting a real test of judgement for line and speed. The fairways are lush and well-maintained. This is a quality golfing experience which will bring you back for more.

Members and green fee players can enjoy practice facilities including a driving range, practice nets, chipping green and a large practice putting green.

Electric carts are available for hire complete with rain-covers and eskies. Competition golf is available most days with social golf available every day.

The club is now utilising MiClub software and visitors can book social games and carts on line, but should call the pro shop to book into a competition.

The pro shop, staffed by long-term professional Glenn Warne, is open seven days a week from 7am and has an extensive range of products for sale.

Glenn and his assistant professional, Glenn Dick, are also available for lessons.

Clubhouse facilities offered in The 28th provide members and guests with a welcoming indoor and outdoor alfresco space with extensive and panoramic views, perfect for enjoying a cool drink after a round of golf or simply drop in for a coffee as you walk or cycle between Pambula and Merimbula.

The club hosts two major golfing tournaments each year. Ace of Clubs this year will be held from June 10-24. This is a stableford tournament played across four

Heritage Golf and Country Club

HERITAGE GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB

HERITAGE Golf and Country Club is more than a world-class golf course.

At the base of the Yarra Valley, surrounded by the rising hills of the Warrandyte State Forest and the meandering Yarra River, Heritage is also home to 200 residents and a thriving golfing community where friendships are established and continue for life.

This story is one of friendship and camaraderie built by four men who have been living and playing golf together, twice a week, for more than 20 years.

In 1998, the decision to buy a block of land at Heritage required imagination and vision. All four were retiring from significant professional lives and had not yet met.

Today, at 86, David Curry is a Heritage honorary member. He was the first chair of

the members elected committee and the first club president, serving from 2003 to 2007.

His three best mates are Bill Pratt who's 96, George Harding who's 93 and Wilfrid van Dorsser, who is 86. Bill, George and Wilfrid are inaugural members of the Heritage Veterans Club.

The foursome has played in the Heritage comps twilight round each week in summer and often a couple of other games during the week. A rough calculation puts that at well over 3000 games played together on the two Heritage courses. They continue to play most Monday and Friday mornings.

Explaining their history of friendship, David says: "Bill moved into Heritage soon after me in 2000 and then George – and it feels like we've been here forever. At the time, there was nothing – it was just a worksite.

"There was no golf course or clubhouse and it was hard to picture the potential. We would open the back gate by ourselves. There was a night watchman who sat in his car with a 12-

volt television. He kept an eye on the place."

Bill had been the chief and managing director of Australian Safeway. In 1946, as a young man, he bought Pratt's Store in the outer Melbourne suburb of Frankston and became a pioneer of self-service and supermarkets.

He caught the eye of US company, Safeway, and in 1963 his three stores merged with the giant supermarket chain. In 1967, he took the helm of Australian Safeway and by 1985, 130 Safeway stores were operating throughout Australia.

"For 50 years, it was a big job," said Bill. "I always said, when I retire, I'll play golf.

"The Heritage agent put me in a four-wheel drive and gave me a piece of paper with a plan on it. I remember getting to the 11th on St John and it was a quarry. I said, 'what are you going to do with a hole like that?'"

Bill and Dave chose sites near the eighth and a week later, George chose a site near the 18th.

"Initially, there were so few houses finished, that we used to go to each other's homes, and we'd knock on the door and introduce ourselves. That's how it all started – the friendships," explained George.

Their bond was cemented at Heritage and as David continued: "I'd never met Bill, and would never have been in a position to meet Bill. He was one of the big professional guys."

By the time Wilfrid arrived at Heritage two years later, the clubhouse was built, and the golf course was close to being finished.

David met him and said: "The residents will be playing on Friday morning at 11am, be there!"

And that's how it began.

Heritage was opened in November 2000 and the following year, Wilfrid had a hole-in-one, aged 75.

Quite a few years later, Bill had an ace, aged 90.

"We have treated each other as friends and neighbours ... and I couldn't say that about anyone else," David said. "It doesn't get any better than our experience at Heritage.

"We live and play golf together. We started as a golfing group, and we were residents and Heritage members. In time, we established our friendship and we are a great group of golfing mates. We have a strong bond and it's important to us. We don't go over the top with each other, but if one of us needs something, the rest of us are there."

George added: "Our wives played golf and are friends too. We have a regular Friday lunch but there are six of us now. Wilfrid and Bill's wives died a few years ago.

"The important thing is, we all support each other. If any of these guys needed anything, I'd be there. For 22 years, it's never been any different."

PALMER COOLUM RESORT

WITHOUT a doubt, Palmer Coolum Resort has a superb layout and it's definitely worth playing more than once simply because you will want to after exiting the 18th green.

You may well be distracted by the picturesque beauty of the lakes and tropical foliage, but it's one of those challenging courses from which you learn so much the first time.

Designed by Robert Trent Jones Jnr, the course is not overly long, but it's a great test of golf.

The best piece of advice from the experts is "keep your golf ball in play" and "don't take driver off the tee on all the par-4s and par-5s" especially on the front nine holes.

Set against the backdrop of Mount Coolum, the 18-hole championship course is a par 72 and has three sets of tee blocks – black (championship), blue (men's) and red (women)

The greens often have a sharp rise between the front and back and the vast majority of greens are relatively narrow at the front, widening as they deepen.

The bunkers don't have steep faces, but that doesn't mean some of them are not deep.

The Resort is undertaking a full refurbishment with plans underway to upgrade the course including bunkers, cart paths and bridges which will also include increasing the length of various holes to deliver a fine test of championship golf.

For those who love to practice, there is also a 250m driving range, a large putting green as well as a fully-stocked pro shop and a fleet of 76 golf carts.

There is a comfortable yet unpretentious bar where you can sit and relax with a cold beer, glass of wine or soft-drink.

Palmer Coolum Resort no longer has a membership base and that's been good for visiting club and social golfers and groups.

The golfing public can access the course seven days a week, however bookings are essential. Green and cart fees are \$135 in a shared golf cart or \$86 for nine holes.

How to get there: From Brisbane, head north to the Sunshine Coast (approximately 130 kilometres). The resort is 10 minutes from the Sunshine Coast Airport.

Holes 10-18 require length and accuracy with correct shot-selection and execution necessary in order to play this nine successfully.

The final four holes are a magnificent test and will either make or break your round as water is a prominent feature when you come down the stretch.

The 17th is one of the best par-3s in golf. It's a demanding 190m across water to a green that's protected by bunkers left and right.

The 18th requires a good, long and accurate tee-shot. From there it's uphill to an elevated, two-tier green that will test all your putting skills.

Holes 19-27 place a premium on accuracy as the Kedron Brook winds its way throughout. Any wayward shots tend to find a hazard. The combinations of these three very different nines will undoubtedly test all facets of any golfer's game.

Keperra CGC is open to public access/pay-to-play golf seven days a week.

That should tell you something about the quality of this tropical gem, located in Noosa Heads, just 3km from Noosa's famous Hasting Street on Queensland's Sunshine Coast.

But it's not just the magnificent course that visitors rave about, it's the charm and beauty of the surroundings, the warmth of the welcome and, most of all, the outstanding service provided by Noosa Springs' dedicated staff that remains in the memory.

Noosa Springs is a bit of everything. It's a resort, offering luxury accommodation, a world-class day spa, tennis, a fitness centre and a restaurant that serves its own unique brand of quality cuisine.

It's also a members' club, with a cohort of enthusiastic golfers regularly competing against each other for prizes and bragging rights. But it's also a golf facility where visitors are encouraged and always made welcome, irrespective of their ability on the fairways.

Designed by golf architect Graham Papworth, the par-72 6180m layout is set amidst tropical bushland, making for an enjoyable, yet challenging, round of golf.

Water comes into play on 12 of the holes and the fairways are framed by stands of tropical rainforest.

Visiting golfers have seven-days-a-week access to the course, and the opportunity to play in competitions such as the weekly Sunday Series, the annual Queensland A, B & C Championships and the quarterly Noosa Springs Skins and Ladies Series, which attract players from near and far.

Casual green fees (for 18 holes) are \$125, which includes the cost of an electric cart. You can also save by booking online. There are special rates for groups of 12 or more, while locals – those who live on the Sunshine Coast or Gympie – can play on Tuesdays and Sundays for \$89 (with a cart). Kids play free every day after 3pm with a paying adult every day except Saturdays.

Beerwah Golf Club

BEERWAH GOLF CLUB

NESTLED within the surrounds of the ancient volcanic remnants of the Glass House Mountains is the quiet little town of Beerwah where crocs rule and a one-time Open champion, Ian Baker Finch, first honed his golfing skills.

Beerwah Golf Club is a flat, easy walking golf course but one where most visitors walk off the 18th green, shaking their heads, wondering why their score is not better and vowing to have a better result next time.

At a little over 6000 metres, the golf course is not overly long by today's standards. The fairways are not cramped but neither are they generous and a push or pull off the tee will find your ball amongst the tree-line. That is unless it is one of the holes with out of bounds or water adjacent to the fairway.

The greens are widely acknowledged as the best on the Sunshine Coast and are generally a quickish pace, but always true. That, combined with most greens being small and raised means that an up-and-down is a tricky

proposition particularly from over the back of the green.

For that reason, it is paramount to find the fairway off the tee and longer hitters may wish to leave the driver in the bag on the par-4s.

Hitting the green with your approach shot is therefore the key to a good score and the fickle wind that for some reason always seems to be into the player makes that a touch more difficult.

After the round you can enjoy a well-earned beer in the cheery clubhouse and discuss the vagaries of the swirling wind or that chip that just missed the hole and finished 15 feet down the green.

Beerwah Golf Club is a must visit the next time that you are anywhere near the Sunshine Coast.
