**TUROSS HEAD COUNTRY CLUB**

LOCATED between Narooma and Moruya on the New South Wales south coast is a signpost on the busy Princes Highway reading “6 kms to Tuross Head”.

A quiet seaside community of 2000 people located on a headland that juts out into the Tasman Sea, with Coila Lake to the north and Tuross Lake and Tuross River to the south. The township is virtually surrounded by water. So, take a moment, turn at the signpost and have a look around.

Turn off the highway and travel along a narrow neck of land with Coila Lake (home to the sailing club) on the left, past a sporting oval, practice cricket nets, tennis and basketball courts and lakeside BBQ area.

There is another expanse of water on the right, the Tuross River, which flows into Tuross Lake and then out to the Tasman Sea. There is ideal fishing on the river, lakes or beaches.

Next stop at is a viewing area overlooking the Tuross Head Country Club golf course.

This course is rated one the 25 best 9-hole golf courses in Australia. The panorama is superb.

The Great Dividing Range in the distance, the lake and ocean views and the golf course, invite you to get out both your camera and your golf clubs.

Visitors are invited to join in the regular men, ladies and veteran 9 or 18-hole competitions (weekly golf memberships are available) or you can just enjoy a social round. Hire the latest golf carts, buggies and clubs.

Two bowling greens are available for family and social use.

A modern two-story clubhouse, a large newly paved car park, sports bar, all

amenities and a genuine welcome to visitors by staff and members is a hallmark of the club.

Enjoy live entertainment and dancing on Saturday nights.

Call up the club’s courtesy bus, take a lift up to the Tuross Head Country Club OceanView Brasserie, which features a panoramic vista and offers a wide selection of Australian and Asian food.

The restaurant has a high reputation, its food preparation and presentation are excellent and cater for groups, families and children.

## THE SOUTH COAST GOLF TRAIL

### Where did your group base themselves on the South Coast?

We stayed close to Club Catalina which was great for us to be close to all of the facilities it offers; Catalina Restaurant, The Bar and other services it provides our group, and have always been very happy with it. It works well for us. Being a golf weekend we arranged a few things in the club after our golf, mainly a punters afternoon, that combined with time of year being Football Semi Final time, we don't get out to look around.
