For golfers, the number and variety of golf courses on the Sunshine Coast is heavenly.

Here you will find a richness of golf courses from challenging layouts, subtle links-style layouts that jump up and grab you and gentler tracks that yield an enjoyable, fun-filled round.

More than 30 golf courses – ranging from alluring nine-hole layouts to 18-hole

captivating championship courses – offer countless, changing challenges.

All the golf courses, many designed by architects with international reputations, offer excellent standards and there is always a warm welcome.

No destination for holiday golf offers such easy access, whether you take your car or fly in to the Sunshine Coast Airport at Maroochydore, you can still hope to play somewhere on the day you arrive.

Most golf clubs spare no expense in creating well-maintained golf courses with plenty of space for visiting golfers to play.

Lush fairways, manicured greens, comfortable clubhouses and moderate costs – holiday golf on the Sunshine Coast has never looked better.

Here are a few of our favourite Sunshine Coast gems.



TWIN WATERS GOLF CLUB

Like the best links designed anywhere, Twin Waters golf course is a stern and stunning test of championship golf.

Rated among the leading courses in Australia the 6183m links, centrally located just five kilometres from the Sunshine Coast Airport, is a must see while visiting the Sunshine Coast region.

The Peter Thomson and Mike Wolveridge-designed course starts on relatively flat land and builds steadily to a crescendo of great finishing holes that traipse through mounds and undulations, not to mention the many kangaroos relaxing on the fairways as well. The course exacts its toll for the early favours, however, building slowly but surely into difficulty and interest on both the front and back nine.

Concentration is critical on the putting surfaces because the greens are typical of links golf – large with subtle slopes.

The eighth hole is just one of the standouts because it has the green designed in line with the “road hole” at St Andrews. The water on the right is intimidating and is a definite “no-go zone”.

The 18th is a suitably testing par-5 and it is a hole where many contests have been won ... and lost.

Twin Waters is always in pristine condition, which is the one of memorable experiences of a visit to a course that rightly boasts “fairways like carpet” and fits the classic description “tranquil and unpretentious”.

There’s a real comfortable, polished feel about the course, clubhouse and facilities which makes the experience a pleasure.

Twin Waters Golf Club is open to visitors and social clubs seven days a week and offers packages for all sizes of groups.

Twin Waters is also the only Sunshine Coast course with GPS Visage system in its golf carts, which is great for visitors and guests.

The aquatic driving range is a unique experience.

The range is where you intentionally hit balls into the water as you warm-up for your round.

It’s just another enjoyable experience offered at Twin Waters.

The fully-licensed clubhouse is open every day for coffee and lunch with a variety of menu items from which to choose at very

reasonable prices.

Twin Waters Golf Club is also a leading Sunshine Coast wedding venue and winner of the 2018 Brides Choice award.



CALOUNDRA GOLF CLUB

Not far from famed Kings Beach at Caloundra is the equally impressive Caloundra Golf Club.

The charming parkland golf course is set in a tranquil and peaceful environment and offers a pleasant combination of ponds and well-established trees and interesting strategy decisions off the tees.

Long before the resort-style courses arrived on the Sunshine Coast scene, Caloundra was attracting new members and visitors to the well-established club and layout.

Caloundra GC opened in 1951 as a nine-hole layout and extended to 18 holes in 1966 and it is here where visiting club golfers feel right at home as the golf course is very much a product of its natural surroundings.

Of course, the challenge of the traditional Australian bushland course is another reason why the club is popular with members and visitors alike.

Off the championship tees, the golf course stretches to 5957 metres (5363m for women).

The delightful, picturesque course features a number of tight, tree-lined holes that make accuracy and the ability to shape the golf ball off the tee important.

And that means the layout is a balance between risk and reward.

You can smash a driver off the tee or hit a positional iron, go for the green in two heroic shots or throw a wedge to the superb greens.

There are five par-3s and they are a real test with none measuring less than 145 metres.

If that is not enough, there is water on five holes and bunkers protect most greens.

Caloundra golf course's final three holes are extremely demanding – just what you want from a championship layout.

The 16th (353m) has an index of nine, the 17th (369m) index of three and the 18th (393m) is indexed at one.

If you require one birdie from the final three holes to win a title, you are going to have to work very hard indeed.

Caloundra Golf Club, which can lay claim to producing former British Open champion Ian Baker-Finch, has produced numerous state and national champions.

Visitors are always welcome at Caloundra and social times are available most days.

Motorised carts and golf equipment are available for hire.

The clubhouse, which overlooks the 18th green and fairway, incorporates a fully-equipped bar and dining room and also specialises in weddings, birthdays or any other celebration while the pro shop has an excellent range of clubs and accessories.

One of the attractions is each day at 4pm the Rainbow Lorikeets arrive on time and visitors are welcome to participate in the feeding activity.

The scope of works planned is certainly something to behold. In the near future, Pelican Waters Golf Club will feature a brand-new hotel (clubhouse), Pro Shop with café, an Australian first Greg Norman-designed mini golf course, a world class driving range and training facility with the latest technology.

Greg Norman's team is working closely with the construction and development team to ensure the new-look back nine will remain in keeping with Norman's original vision for this course. Ideally situated just 20 minutes north of Maroochydore, and 30 minutes south of Noosa Heads, the picturesque Mount Coolum Golf Club offers a challenging and interesting layout with an abundance of kangaroos and other wildlife that golfers of all standards can enjoy.

Measuring 5,901m from the Black Tees, and 5,149m from the Reds, the unusual composition of six par-3 holes, six par-4 holes, and six par-5s offers some relief for inexperienced golfers on the short holes, whilst requiring some accurate tee shots from better players on the longer holes.

Social golfers can get on the course most days, with Mondays, Fridays and Sundays having the most availability.

The club will host the Queensland Senior Men's and Women's Amateur Championship,

and the Queensland Women's Mid-Amateur Championship for the second time in August this year, and also conducts the Mount Coolum 3-Day Team Classic every June.

Not only is Mount Coolum a great place for a round of golf, the club also has an interesting catering offering. Rusty's Food & Barbecue has been providing their authentic slow-cooked barbecue fare at Mount Coolum for the past year or so, and is regularly topping 100 meals on a Friday evening. The Rusty's Signature Burger - with slow-smoked brisket, is worth the trip on its own.

Your meal from Rusty's can be washed down with a cold beverage - perhaps one of the four beers sourced from local Sunshine Coast craft breweries.

Mount Coolum also accepts group bookings and is very popular with social golf clubs, and with most competitions being open - including Saturdays, it also a great option for a weekend away or golf holiday.

MAROOCHY RIVER GOLF CLUB

The first thing you notice about Maroochy River Golf Club is the spectacular view to Mount Coolum. Undulating fairways and breathtaking water features sit proudly below one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the Sunshine Coast.

Since opening in June 2015, Maroochy River Golf Club has really blossomed into a world class destination, with an impressive average of 75,000 rounds per year.

The Graham Marsh-designed layout will challenge all level of players and leave you wanting to come back for more. When Marsh designed and built Maroochy River, he promised a gutsy (risk-and-reward) course, and he certainly delivered.

The course is rated #54 in Australia's Top 100 Public Access Courses, and is named in Australia's Top 100 Golf Courses debuting at #76.

At Maroochy River there is one superb hole after another, featuring stunning drives and greens protected by bunkers, plenty of water and a family of black swans if you are lucky enough to see them.

Profoundly different to any other course in Queensland, the links-style layout winds its way through strategic waterways and wetlands. It has matured beautifully and is described by members and visitors alike as an "awesome experience".

"We have many repeat visitors who just love the place," said general manager Charlie McGill.

The course has held eight State titles and two National titles including the 2019 Australian Men's Senior Amateur Championships. The Schweppes PGA Legends Pro-Am will be a featured 2-day event on the calendar for 2021.

For those golfers who enjoy warming up before a round, Maroochy River has excellent practice facilities. Just like the golf course, it has that wow factor.


