BUNDABERG GOLF CLUB

BUNDABERG Golf Course is a meticulously maintained 18-hole Championship Golf Course in North Bundaberg - just five minutes' drive from the Bundaberg city centre and less than 20 minutes from Bargara Beach.

Facilities also include a practice putting green just outside the Pro Shop and a driving range that runs parallel to the 18th fairway.

Golf clubs, push buggies, and motorised carts are available for hire from the fully-stocked Pro Shop, which boasts an impressive range of equipment as well as a comprehensive selection of golfing

accessories. One of Bundaberg's friendly and knowledgeable Pro Shop staff will be only too happy to assist.

All facilities are available to the public and Bundaberg can arrange Corporate Golf Days or social functions.

Each year Bundaberg Golf Club proudly hosts the Burnett Cup, Wide Bay's Premier Matchplay event for male and female golfers. The competition begins in January and concludes towards the end of February. HERVEY BAY GOLF CLUB

THE Hervey Bay course is a challenging 18-hole layout of rare quality, one that can test the best golfers, with strategically bunkered greens, lush fairways and an excellent practice area.

Built on generally flat land, the course measures 5897 metres, with a par of 70 for men, with two par threes and one par five on each nine. Women play a 5217m course as a par 72, with extra shots on the demanding ninth and 15th holes.

The course looks a picture and attracts an abundance of birds and native wildlife, including kangaroos which appear in the early morning and late afternoon to nibble the luxuriant grass.

Professional golfers gather each July to contest the two-day Fraser Coast Legends Classic, and are always complimentary of

the course, describing it as 'testing and a real challenge.

Members and guests have the chance to play competition golf seven days a week the Vets on Mondays, with male and female members competing together every day

Also, there is always opportunity for members and visitors to play social golf.

Golf memberships cost \$1056, with categories for Country Members (\$620), Juniors (from \$182 to \$277), Temporary Members (\$130 for a month) and Friday Members, who pay \$222 to be eligible to play in the Club's popular nine hole Friday competition
